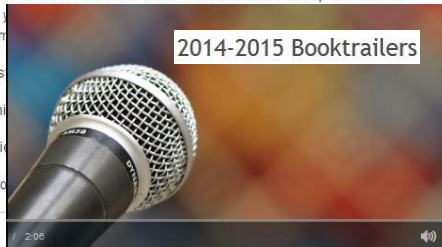


Babies, Toddlers and Preschoolers[top]

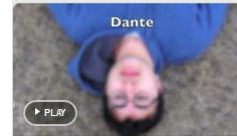
